Qualifications for Applicants

1. Applicants must be 18 years or older and live in the United States. Applicants must have completed high school or received a GED.
2. Applicants **cannot be previous recipients of this scholarship.**
3. Applicants must be accepted into a Paramedic program that takes place in the Spring 2023 semester at a college or university, or a program as part of a non-profit organization, which must be in the United States.
4. Scholarship recipients will receive \$1,000. Scholarships are for **tuition only**, and will be paid directly to the Bursar at the program.
5. Approved scholarships **cannot be used for fees outside of tuition**, including but not limited to books, supplies, lab fees or registration fees.
6. Applicants must maintain a passing grade and complete the course in order to keep tuition funding. If an applicant should fail or withdraw from the course for any reason, the **full amount of tuition shall be returned to Bryant Gladney Foundation LLC**. Proof of academic standing may be requested by the Bryant Gladney Foundation LLC at any time.
