



Bryant Gladney Paramedic Education Scholarship Application Information

Scholarship Cycles

- **Spring Scholarship:** Applications are open from October 1 - December 1 each year.
 - The Spring Scholarship is for students enrolled at any point between January 1 and July 31 of the following year.
- **Fall Scholarship:** Applications are open from May 1 - July 1 each year.
 - The Fall Scholarship is for students enrolled at any point between August 1 and December 31 of that year.

Scholarship Guidelines

- This scholarship application is for students who will be enrolled in a paramedic class. This paramedic class must prepare the student for the National Registry exam.
 - EMR, EMT or pre-requisite anatomy & physiology classes are not eligible.
 - Critical Care Paramedic, Flight Paramedic or other additional classes are not eligible.
- The paramedic class must be taught at an institution that holds active institutional accreditation from a regional or national accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education or the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA), or holds accreditation from the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP).

- Note: Programs currently holding a Letter of Review (LoR) from the Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoAEMSP) while actively seeking CAAHEP accreditation may be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- A previous Bryant Gladney Foundation scholarship recipient is not eligible to apply.
- The scholarship award will be in the amount of \$2,000 and will be paid directly to the recipient's institution for tuition only.
- Recipients will be required to successfully pass and complete their course or they must repay their scholarship award.

Documents Needed

- **Letter of Recommendation:** Submit a signed letter of recommendation from a non-relative who has personal knowledge of your career goals and work ethic.
- **Transcripts:** You must upload transcripts (whether high school and/or college) that account for the last **three (3) academic years** you have been enrolled. Transcripts must show courses and grades, however they can be "unofficial" transcripts. You must upload your TRANSCRIPTS, not your diplomas or degrees.
- **DD-214 or other Military Records** (if applicable): If you have served in the armed forces please upload documentation to show your service. We appreciate your service and are honored to award you 5 extra points.
- **Essay:** You will be given two prompts to choose from and you must write an essay answering one prompt. The prompts will be announced in the application.
- **Upload all required documents in PDF format.**

Application

- **Online Application:** The application is entirely online and can be found at gladneyfoundation.org under the Scholarship page. The application will only be open during the specified application periods.
- **Eligibility Quiz:** The beginning of the application contains an eligibility quiz in which all questions must be "True" in order for an applicant to be eligible. If you

answer "False" to any question, you are not eligible and the remainder of the application will be blank.

- **Save and Submit:** You can save your application and return to it later if needed. Click "Save for Later" at the bottom of any page and then follow the directions to receive an email link. Once you are confident that your application is complete and accurate, click the "Submit" button.
